Class 1- \$50

- small service & supply company)
 - general guideline = 1 to 3 employees

Class 2- \$100

- financial institution or medium supply & service company
 - inactive exploration or mining company (minimal to no budget, minimal to no revenue)
 - general guideline = 3 to 10 employees
-

Class 3- \$300

- small exploration company (budget <\$500,000)
- large service & supply company
- general guideline = 10 to 15 employees

e.g. DDH Companies, Assay Labs, Rental Car agencies, Airlines, Hotels

Class 4- \$500

- medium to large exploration company (budget >\$500,000)
 - general guideline = 15 to 50 employees

- operating mine
